SUBJECT: Asbestos Update

In 1986 the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) was signed into law requiring all non-profit Public and Private Schools (K-12) to inspect for the presence of Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBM). Academy District 20 has completed the initial inspection on all buildings in the district and continues to monitor the status of any materials that were found during inspections. A copy of the inspection and the Management Plan for your building, devised to keep in compliance with applicable regulations, can be viewed at the main building or at the Facilities Management Office located at 10221 Lexington Drive, Colorado Springs, CO 80920.

Your school was inspected for asbestos on May 19, 1988, and no asbestos containing materials were found. However, a re-inspection performed in 2006 indicated a presence of ACBM in portable #22. Students and staff are being protected from exposure by a perpetual program of control, inspection, and preventive maintenance.

Academy District 20 is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our students and staff.
